## ~Responsibility~ Your Commitment of Support (suggested ©)

- Monitor grades and show interest in learning
- Monitor
  - Organizational tools like backpack, notebooks, planner
  - Comments about academics, social, general comfort level
- Encourage self-advocacy and risk-taking
  - Start with "processing" problems before fixing for them
  - Check in with us for clarification or support

#### Attendance

- ♦ Absences, excused or unexcused, affect learning
- ♦ Being sick vs. being sick of school use our nurse
- Students feeling sick go to nurse during the day
- ♦ Students check in/out at attendance office
- Excuse absences promptly

#### Grades

- Grade reports mailed home at end of quarters
- Parents can check online anytime... but there's a lag
- Hold your student accountable for first attempts to resolve grade concerns
- Contact teachers directly with specific concerns
- Contact counselors for broad concerns
